

Official Rules

Starting on April 16, 2018, Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and the Jimmy Fund ("DFCI") will invite New England little league baseball teams via email, program website (www.jimmyfundlittleleague.org), and other methods to register a team for the 2018 Jimmy Fund Little League program co-presented by Extra Innings and Franklin Sports (together, the "Participating Teams"). The Team Coach of each Participating Team who chooses to respond to the invitation must: (i) visit the URL reflected in the invitation and (ii) supply all requested information in a complete and accurate fashion to DFCI. Participating Teams or individuals who meet the criteria as described below between April 16, 2018 at 12:01am EST and August 13, 2018 at 11:59pm EST will be eligible for a chance to win any of the prizes described below.

The winners will be determined at DFCI: 10 Brookline Place West, 6th Floor, Brookline, Massachusetts, on August 14, 2018 at 12:00pm EST. The Senior Vice President for Development, or her/his designee, shall be responsible for determining the names of the potential winners.

The potential winners will be notified by phone, mail and/or email. If a potential winner cannot be reached after fourteen (14) days from the first notification attempt, or if a participant is found to be ineligible, or if the notification is returned or undeliverable, or if a participant declines "winner" status, that participant will forfeit all rights as the winner, and an alternate winner will be selected. In the event the alternate winner declines the prize, the prize may be designated for another DFCI fundraising event at DFCI's sole discretion. Prizes will be shipped via a traceable method of delivery.

In order to be eligible to participate in the contests, a Participating Team Coach must, as of the date of entry: (i) be eighteen (18) years of age or older, and (ii) be a legal resident of one of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia. Directors, officers and employees of DFCI, and persons otherwise affiliated with DFCI, are not eligible to win prizes; this includes immediate family members of any of the aforementioned groups. The term "immediate family" includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws," or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, co-habitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related.

The Participating Team with the highest fundraising total from each district as of August 13, 2018 at 11:59pm EST will each receive twenty-five (25) tickets to the Boston Red Sox vs. New York Mets game at Fenway Park in Boston, Massachusetts on September 15, 2018 at 4:05pm EST, with seats located in the right field grandstand, a Jimmy Fund goody bag for each player, recognition at the game on Fenway Park's center field JumboTron, and the chance to attend a pre-game ceremony and check presentation at Fenway Park's Champions Club. Districts must raise a minimum of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for their teams to be eligible to win this prize. This prize has a fair market value of seven hundred dollars (\$700) per team.

Further, Participating Teams from the district that collectively raises the most money as of August 13, 2018 at 11:59pm EST will be invited to attend a League Appreciation Night held by Extra Innings before the start of the 2019 season. The evening will be open to all coaches, parents and players in the winning district who participated in the 2018 Jimmy Fund Little League program. The winning district will receive information on the facility location and how to schedule the clinic. This prize has a fair market value of one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

The Participating Team from each district who wins the Jimmy Fund Little League Tournament will receive a Jimmy Fund Little League plaque for each player on the team after the championship game. This prize has a fair market value of four dollars and fifty cents (\$4.50) per plaque.

The participant with the highest fundraising total from each district as of August 13, 2018 at 11:59pm EST will each receive one (1) official Jimmy Fund Baseball jersey, one (1) piece of Boston Red Sox autographed memorabilia (certificate of authenticity not included), two (2) tickets to the Boston Red Sox vs. New York Nets at Fenway Park in Boston, Massachusetts on September 15, 2018 at 04:05pm EST, with seats located in the right field grandstand, a chance to attend a pre-game ceremony and check presentation at Fenway Park's Championship Club, and the chance to participate in an on-field check presentation at Fenway Park in Boston, Massachusetts on September 15, 2018 before the game. This prize has a combined fair market value of one hundred dollars (\$100) per winner.

The participant with the second highest fundraising total from each district as of August 13, 2018 at 11:59pm EST will each receive one (1) fifty-dollar (\$50) gift certificate to Dick's Sporting Goods. This prize has a combined fair market value of fifty dollars (\$50) per winner.

The Jimmy Fund Little League program will note the participant with the highest fundraising total from each district as of August 13, 2018 at 11:59pm EST (collectively, the "Top Fundraisers"). Within the Top Fundraisers, the participant with the overall highest fundraising total will receive a Pinch Hitter Package at the 2019 John Hancock Fenway Fantasy Day to benefit the Jimmy Fund at Fenway Park in Boston, Massachusetts. Date and time of 2019 John Hancock Fenway Fantasy Day will be provided to the winning participant when available. This prize package has a fair market value of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) and includes:

- Batting for one (1) participant (twenty [20] pitches at bat);
- Lunch or dinner at Fenway Park;
- John Hancock Fenway Fantasy Day T-shirt;
- Goody Bag and Jimmy Fund hat;
- Warm-up batting session in the visitor's batting cages;
- Exclusive access to the visitor's locker room and visitor's dugout;
- Announcement of your at-bat over the Fenway Park public announcement system;
- Chance to run the bases after your at-bat;
- Projection of your name on Fenway Park's JumboTron;
- Admission for five (5) guests to cheer you on from the grandstands (note that food, dugout, and on-field access is limited to the on-field participant only).

Within the Top Fundraisers, the participants with the second and third highest fundraising totals will receive two (2) tickets to the Boston Red Sox vs. New York Yankees game at Fenway Park in Boston, Massachusetts on September 29, 2018, with seats located in the right field grandstand, and the chance to watch the third inning of the game from Fenway Park's WEEI Radio Announcer's Booth. This prize has a combined fair market value of one hundred fifty-two dollars (\$152) per winner.

Within the Top Fundraisers, the participant with the fourth highest fundraising totals will receive one (1) tour of the 17th Annual WEEI/NESN Jimmy Fund Radio-Telethon on August 21 and August 22 of year 2018 at Fenway Park, Boston, Massachusetts. This prize has a fair market value of seventy-five dollars (\$75).

Each participant that creates an individual fundraising page on the Jimmy Fund Little League website (www.jimmyfundlittleleague.org) will receive a Jimmy Fund Little League iron-on patch. The fair market value of this item is de minimis.

The first two (2) new participants to sign up online and raise one thousand dollars (\$1,000) online as of August 13, 2018 at 11:59pm EST will receive an Extra Innings Grand Slam Player Pack at the Extra Innings location of their choice. This prize package includes:

- Ten dollars (\$10) off all batting tunnel rentals;
- Ten dollars (\$10) off all private lessons with a professional instructor;
- Sixty dollars (\$60) off all lesson packs;
- Up to fifty dollars (\$50) off camps/clinics and leagues;
- Ten percent (10%) off of all Extra Innings Pro Shop Purchases;
- Unlimited use of the Extra Innings members training area; and
- Twenty dollars (\$20) off party packages.

All package benefits are valid for one (1) full year. This package has a combined fair market value of four hundred ninety-five dollars (\$495) per winner.

The first Participating Team to sign up online and raise one thousand dollars (\$1,000) online as of May 29, 2018 at 11:59pm EST will receive one (1) free admission to the Jimmy Fund Scooper Bowl, occurring on June 5, 6, and 7 of year 2018 at Boston's City Hall Plaza. This prize has a fair market value of fifteen dollars (\$15) per participant.

The first twelve (12) Participating Teams to sign up online and raise one thousand dollars (\$1,000) online will receive one (1) hour in the batting cages as a team or one (1) private lesson as a team at an Extra Innings location of the winning team's choice. This prize has a fair market value of five hundred dollars (\$500) per team.

The top twenty-five (25) participants to sign up online and have the highest fundraising totals will receive four (4) tickets to the Worcester Bravehearts vs. North Shore Navigators game on July 24, 2018 at 06:30PM EST in Fitton Field in Worcester, Massachusetts. This prize has a combined fair market value of thirty-two dollars (\$32) per participant.

NO PURCHASE OR CONTRIBUTION NECESSARY TO ENTER. Maximum of one (1) entry per Participating Team or individual participant per contest. The odds of winning depend on the number of valid entries received. Please contact the Special Events Office at 617-632-3863 to request an "entry form" if you would like to participate in the Jimmy Fund Little League program and its contests without registering a team or contributing to or raising funds for DFCL. All entries must be complete to be eligible. Deadline to enter is August 13, 2018 at 11:59pm EST, except where otherwise indicated herein.

Prizes are non-transferrable, non-refundable, non-negotiable, not redeemable for cash or for re-sale, and no substitution will be allowed. Prizes will not be replaced if lost or stolen. Other restrictions may apply. Should a prize become unavailable to DFCL for any reason, DFCL reserves the right to substitute an item of equal or lesser value. If a prize is date-specific, winners must be available on the date(s) specified. Winners may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility, a receipt, a Certificate of Intent, and/or a waiver form provided by DFCL, prior to receipt of the prize.

Any valuation of the prizes stated above is based on available information provided to DFCL, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law. Winners are solely responsible for reporting and paying any and all applicable taxes related to the prize and for paying any expenses associated with a prize which is not specifically provided for in these Official Rules. Winners may be required to provide DFCL with valid identification and a valid taxpayer identification number or social security number before the prize will be awarded. Any person winning over \$600 in prizes from DFCL may receive an IRS form 1099 shortly following the end of the calendar year and a copy of such form will be filed with the IRS. Any person winning \$5,000 or more in prizes from DFCL may be required to pay the applicable taxes to DFCL before any prize will be awarded, per IRS regulations. In the event that a prize is valued at six hundred dollars (\$600) or more and a winner is under eighteen (18) years of age, the prize shall be accepted by their parent or legal guardian on their behalf.

By participating in the contests described above, participants agree to abide by all terms of these Official Rules and all decisions of DFCL, made in its sole discretion, which decisions shall be final. DFCL will interpret these Official Rules and will resolve any disputes, conflicting claims or ambiguities concerning the rules or the contests, and DFCL's decisions concerning such disputes shall be final.

All participants, their heirs, executors and administrators, waive, release and forever discharge DFCL, all sponsoring entities, their respective trustees, directors, officers, employees, and agents, from all claims of liability, damages and rights of action of whatever nature or description, in equity or at law, present and future, that may arise out of or relate to participation in the contests, including the use of any prize.

DFCL is not responsible for lost or stolen prizes, incorrect or inaccurate transcription of entry information, for any human error, technical malfunctions, lost/delayed data transmission, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries, for line failures or other failures of any telephone network, server, providers, computer equipment, software or any combination thereof, for inability to access any web site or online service or any other error or malfunction, or for late, lost, illegible, misdirected or incomplete entries which may limit a participant's ability to participate in the contests. DFCL is not responsible for technical, hardware or software failures of any kind, lost or unavailable network connections or failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmissions.

The contests are governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. By participating in the contests, each participant consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located in Suffolk County, Massachusetts, for resolution of all disputes.
